



Anti Al Wall Hanging

Skill Level: Intermediate

Material

- US G (4.00 mm) crochet hook
- Size #4 worsted weight yarn
 - o 3 colors
 - Color A (tan): 2.4 oz/ 122 yds
 - Color B (red): .7 oz/ 36 yds
 - Color C (black): .3 oz/ 15 yds
- Notions: scissors, measuring tape, yarn needle
- Wooden dowel/ stick (more than 8" across)

Gauge

18 sc x 18 rows = 4" (blocked)

Terms/Stitches Used

• Ch: Chain

St: Stitch

Sc: Single crochet

RS: Right side

Notes

- This pattern is worked from the bottom up, row by row with a turn at the beginning of the rows.
- Begin with a ch 31 in color A, turn, and start in the 2nd ch from the hook. Each row begins with a "ch 1, turn" and all st counts are 30 sc.
- The ch 1 at the beginning of the rows **does not count** as a stitch.
- This whole pattern is worked in sc, so the instructions will only tell you the number and the color; ie: "20" highlighted in red means sc 20 times in your red color.
- This pattern doesn't require you to carry the yarn, just use bobbins where necessary and change colors on the last pull through of the sc.
- Blocking is suggested for this pattern.
- In the photos: Color A is tan, color B is red, and color C is black. Stash yarn was used.

Finished Product Dimensions (not including stick/dowel/fringe)

7.15" wide x 7.15" height





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


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Graph

← Row 1 [RS]: 30

 \rightarrow Row 2 [WS]: 30

← Row 3 [RS]: 8 14 8

 \rightarrow Row 4 [WS]: 6 18 6

 \leftarrow Row 5 [RS]: 5 4 12 4 5

 \rightarrow Row 6 [WS]: 4 3 16 3 4

← Row 7 [RS]: 3 3 16 5 3

 \rightarrow Row 8 [WS]: 3 2 1 3 16 2 3

← Row 9 [RS]: 2 3 15 3 2 3 2

 \rightarrow Row 10 [WS]: 2 2 2 3 1 2 2 8 2 2

← Row 11 [RS]: 2 2 8 2 2 3 1 2 2 2

 \rightarrow Row 12 [WS]: 2 2 2 2 3 1 4 4 4 2 2

← Row 13 [RS]: 2 2 5 3 3 2 2 2 2

 \rightarrow Row 14 [WS]: 2 2 6 3 4 2 5 2 2

← Row 15 [RS]: 2 2 3 3 7 2 2 2


 \rightarrow Row 16 [WS]: 2 2 2 4 2 3 2 5 2 2

← Row 17 [RS]: 2 2 5 2 1 3 1 2 4 2 2 2 2

 \rightarrow Row 18 [WS]: 2 2 3 2 5 2 2

 \leftarrow Row 19 [RS]: 2 2 4 2 3 4 2 2 2 3 2 2

 \rightarrow Row 20 [WS]: 2 2 4 4 4 2 3 3 2 2 2

Fasten off, weave in all your ends. Block your wall hanging if you'd like to.

Border

With the RS facing you, join color A in the first st on the other side of Row 1.

Row 1: A: Ch 1, sc into the next 30 sts, ch 1 at the corner, sc into the next 30 row ends, ch 1 at the corner, sc into the next 30 sts of Row 30, ch 1 at the corner, sc down the next 30 row ends, ch 1 at the corner, join with a slip st - 120 sc, 4 ch-1 spaces

Fasten off, weave in your ends. Block the square so it measures 7.15" x 7.15".

Top/Hanging

With color A (or any color you'd like), sc or sew your wooden dowel or stick to your wall hanging.

For the hanger, ch 50 with color A (or any color you'd like) and tie the ends to the first and last sts on the final row of the wall hanging.
