



RAINBOW MINI MANDALA EARRINGS

Skill Level: Easy

Materials

- 2.00 mm crochet hook
- Size 10 crochet thread
 - Less than .5 oz total
- Needle that will weave in your ends
- [Fabric stiffener](#) (optional)
- [Jump rings](#)
- [Metal french hooks](#)
- Jewelry pliers

Gauge

- 8 scs x 8 rows = 1"

Terms/stitches used

- Magic circle
- Ch: Chain
- St: Stitch
- Slip St: Slip Stitch
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Dc: double crochet
- Dc cluster: the same as a dc3tog but in 1 stitch

Notes

- The ch 1 at the beginning of the some rows **does not** count as a stitch.
- This pattern is worked in the round with a slip st into the first st from the last.
- You will need to know how to make a slipknot on your hook for this pattern.
- Color A is the purple, color B is blue, color C is green, color D is yellow, color E is orange, and color F is red in the photos. [Aunt Lydia's](#) Size 10 crochet threads was used. Less than .1 oz of each color used.

Finished product dimensions

2.75" across



RAINBOW MINI MANDALA EARRINGS

Skill Level: Easy

Pattern Instructions

Rnd 1: A: Create a magic circle, ch 2 (counts as the first leg of the dc cluster), dc2tog into the magic circle, ch 3, *dc cluster, ch 3,* repeat from * to * 3 more times, slip st into the first st - 5 dc clusters, 5 ch-3 spaces

Fasten off color A. Weave in your ends.



Finished Rnd 1

Rnd 2: B: Create a slipknot on your hook, *dc 5 times into the next ch-3 space, ch 1, skip the next dc cluster,* repeat from * to * 4 more times, slip st into the first st - 25 dcs, 5 ch-1 spaces

Fasten off color B. Weave in your ends.



Finished Rnd 2

RAINBOW MINI MANDALA EARRINGS

Skill Level: Easy

Rnd 3: C: Create a slipknot on your hook, skip the next dc from where you fastened off color B on the previous row, dc into the next 3 sts, ch-6, skip the next [dc, ch-1, dc], * dc into the next 3 sts, ch 6, skip the next [dc, ch-1, dc],* repeat from * to * 3 more times, slip st into the first st - 15 dcs, 5 ch-6 spaces

Fasten off color C. Weave in your ends.



Finished Rnd 3

Rnd 4: D: Create a slipknot on your hook, skip the next dc from where you fastened off color C on the previous row, sc into the next st, skip the next st, [6 dc, ch 3, 6 dc] into the ch-6 space, skip the next st, *sc into the next st, skip the next st, [6 dc, ch 3, 6 dc] into the ch-6 space, skip the next st,* repeat from * to * 3 more times, slip st into the first st - 5 scs, 60 scs, 5 ch-3 spaces
Fasten off color D. Weave in your ends.



Finished Rnd 4

RAINBOW MINI MANDALA EARRINGS

Skill Level: Easy

Rnd 5: E: Ch 1, sc into the same st as join and into the next 6 sts, *[sc, ch 2, sc] into the next ch-3 space, sc into the next 13 sts,* repeat from * to * 3 more times, sc into the next 6 sts, slip st into the first st - 75 sc, 5 ch-2 spaces

Fasten off color E. Weave in your ends.



Finished Rnd 5

Rnd 6: F: Ch 1, sc into same st as join, ch 3, skip the next 2 sts, dc into the next 5 sts, [dc, picot, dc] into the ch-2 space, dc into the next 5 sts, ch 3, skip the next 2 sts, *sc into the next sc, ch 3, skip the next 2 sts, dc into the next 5 sts, [dc, picot, dc] into the ch-2 space, dc into the next 5 sts, ch 3, skip the next 2 sts,* repeat from * to * 3 more times, slip st into the first st - 60 dcs, 10 ch-3 spaces, 5 picots

Fasten off color F. Weave in your ends.



Finished Rnd 6

RAINBOW MINI MANDALA EARRINGS

Skill Level: Easy

Finishing

Like I do with all my earrings, I stiffened these with fabric stiffener. Just wet them down with the stiffener (I dilute it with water some) and lay them flat to dry completely. When they're dry, attach the findings and wear everywhere!
